



## Phase 3 Ferry Guidelines

Phase III of Reopening RI began on June 30th. There are no changes from Phase II in regards to ferry guidelines. In accordance with these guidelines, passenger capacity will remain at 30-40% during inclement weather and 50-60% during fair weather. Capacity for all ferry runs is currently set at 40% and is opened to 60% if clear weather is expected, therefore we recommend making all passenger and vehicle reservations well in advance.

**Passengers are reminded to follow spacing demarcations in regards to social distancing at ticketing offices and on-board, to wear facial coverings while at ferry terminals and on-board, and if riding in a vehicle to remain in the vehicle for the duration of ferry travel. Please note new travel restrictions are in place for visitors to Rhode Island. All travelers coming into Rhode Island from a state with a positivity rate of more than 5% are required to quarantine for 14 days, unless they can show proof that they've tested negative for the disease within the three days prior to entering. ## Bristol 4th of July Parade

There will be a parade taking place in Bristol on July 4th. While the parade will be shorter and different from the traditional parade there will still be road closures in Bristol on July 4th beginning at 7:30 AM. Parking bans will also be in effect for many areas in Bristol starting July 3rd. Starting at 7:30 AM and for the duration of the parade road closures will prevent vehicles from accessing the Bristol Ferry terminal. We recommend anyone with reservations on the 7:30 AM or 9:45 AM ferry runs plan ahead for vehicle traffic in Bristol and arrive prior to the road closures. We ask that you please do not take packages from the truck yourself. Please give the crew and office staff time to unload and check in all the packages prior to asking for your packages. If you are signed up for text alert you will receive

a text message from PBIT when your package has arrived on island.
